DESCRIPTION

The role of the Project Director is to lead the day-to-day operations of FUTUREhope whilst working with the trustees to develop strategy and vision.

- To offer support to young people in the local community through one-to-one mentoring.
- Run regular parenting course.
- Regularly attend local churches to promote the work of FUTUREhope.

- Has achieved a recognised qualification in youth work with a JNC and demonstrated a commitment to supporting young people to explore and achieve their full potential.
- Has experience of working in a community youth project and of undertaking outreach youth work.

- Has a demonstrable ability to relate to young people, building supportive and lasting relationships and becoming a trusted person in their lives.
